<p><b>Do</b> ensure that electrical appliances, and multi-way extension leads and adaptors are CE marked.</p>	
	<p><b>Don't</b> allow sockets to be overloaded or multi-way extension leads to be daisy chained.</p>

	<p><b>Don't</b> allow cooking appliances to be used in bedrooms.</p>
<p><b>Do</b> visually inspect appliances for signs of damage (e.g. broken casing, exposed wiring, scorch marks, etc.).</p>	
	<p><b>Don't</b> allow the use of mains powered fairy lights in bedrooms.</p>
<p><b>Do</b> remove any faulty equipment from use and report any hazards or defects observed.</p>
